FRALAP General Information

Family Respite and Leisure Program (FRALAP) is auspiced by Rozelle Neighbourhood Centre Inc. provides one to one respite (in home or community based) for people with a moderate to severe intellectual, physical and /or developmental disability, living with their families. It has a core group of twelve families with additional short emergency respite depending on budgetary constraints.

Families are allocated an average of 190 hours per year, depending on when they use the service. FRALAP employs trained and experienced Support Workers to work with clients.

The project strives for flexibility in service provision to maintain its' relevance to the families it serves. It provides high quality, responsive and individual care programs.

Eligibility Criteria for Clients

FRALAP is available to families providing primary care to a family member who has a moderate to severe developmental, physical or multiple disability.

The eligibility criteria for entry into FRALAP are:

- Aged between 0-65 years
- Living with family in the Inner West area.
- Have moderate to severe level of disability and associated high level of support needs.
