The WERRP PROGRAMME

The programme was created to allow the primary carers of people living with a mild to moderate disability, in the Inner West, the opportunity to receive some respite. This respite takes the form of group activities, including Centre based days and community access outings.

There are two groups that make up the WERRP programme.

The groups operate 48 weeks a year on weekends and take part in centre based activity days and outings in the community.

Activities are chosen by consulting with the participants to see how they would like to spend their leisure time while at the WERRP programme.

The groups activities are led by a team leader with the assistance of support workers/volunteers.

WHO CAN COME TO WERRP?

In order to join in WERRP people must:

- 1. Live in the Inner West.**
- 2. Live at home with their families/carer**
- 3. Have a reasonable level of mobility**
- 4. Be able to participate in activities with a group where there is a team leader, and support worker/volunteer assistants, with a reasonable level of safety.**

COST

Weekly fees are \$5 plus cost of activities. We try to keep activities costs as low as possible, by occasionally subsidizing outings and sourcing sponsorship, or reduced rates from organizations we visit.

If at any time there is concern about payment of fees, please contact the WERRP coordinator.

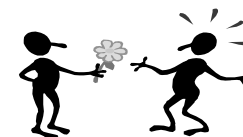
HOW TO JOIN WERRP

In order to participate in the WERRP programme a referral is required. This can be a self-referral, or a referral by a parent, carer or organisation.

Referral forms are available from Rozelle Neighbourhood Centre. We can provide help for you to fill in the referral forms.

Once we receive a referral we conduct an assessment to see if you fit the programme guidelines, and if you do, you are placed on the programme.

When we are full we have a waiting list, so we can let you know as soon as space comes up on the programme.
